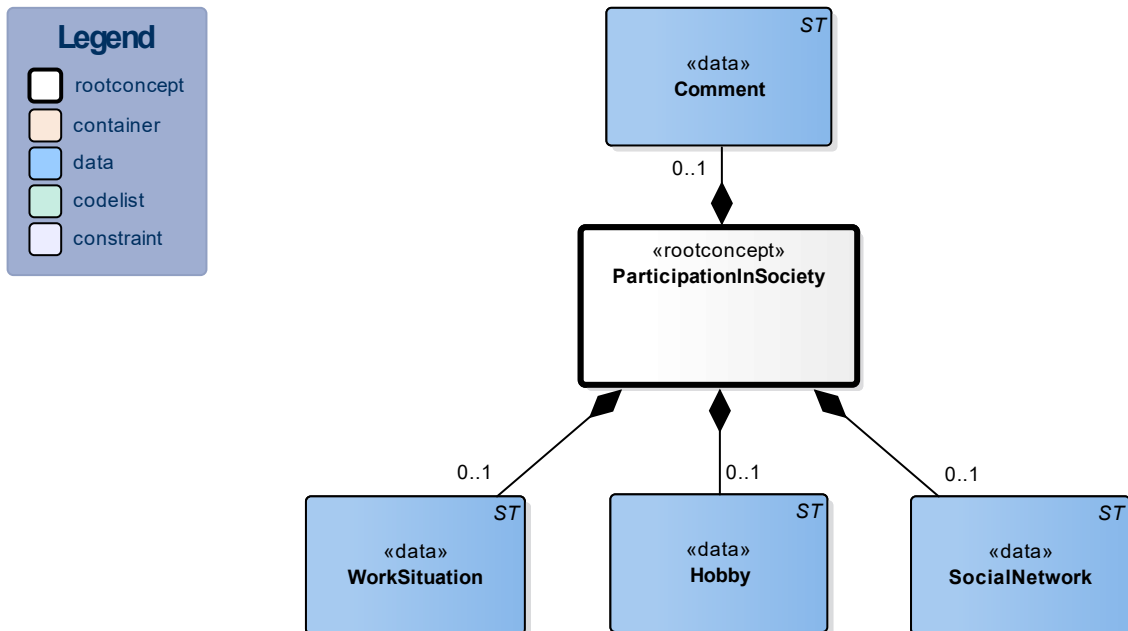
## 1.4 Purpose
