1.4 Purpose

Information on limitations in a patient's ability to bathe themselves is important in determining the nature and intensity of the care the patient needs. In a transfer situation, it gives the receiving organization the

ability to anticipate the intensity of the care to be given to the patient, enabling continuity in healthcare for the patient.

If policy has been implemented to improve a patient's ability to do things independently, the entered extent of independence helps to determine the efficiency of the treatment.



In addition to this information model, there are other tools to record independence, such as the KATZ-ADL and the Barthellndex. The KATZ-ADL is mainly used for vulnerable seniors and the Barthellndex is mainly used for patients who have had a stroke.

This information model evaluates the ability to bathe on a three-point scale. In the KATZ-ADL and in the Barthellndex, this falls under the aspect of Grooming. In these two tools, the ability is scored on a scale with fewer points.
